The Baptism of Christ

The 8th grade bible class is studying The Life of Christ and are currently looking at the baptism of Jesus.



To the left is a painting we observed in class which was commissioned by the San Salvi Church located in Florence. Although Andrea del Verrocchi is credited with the bulk of the work in this painting, certain parts were added or 'touched-up' by Leonardo da Vinci. For example, da Vinci is said to have painted the angel on the left, parts of Jesus' body and then is also reported to have created the rocky scenery background.

Andrea worked on this project between 1472-76 and it was designed to portray the baptism of Jesus by John the Baptist in the Jordan River. The baptism of Jesus is described in all four of the Gospels-Matthew (3:13-17), Mark (1:9-11), Luke (3:21-22) and John (1:29-31) and appears to have been a general baptism.

John the Baptist according to scriptures hesitated at Jesus' request for baptism perhaps feeling a sense of inadequacy at knowing full well exactly the full extent of Jesus' identity. He is, after all, the Son of God that will bring the messianic baptism. He probably asked himself why me? Why am I to baptize HIM-surely there is some mistake? There was of course no mistake and as John consented, the heavens opened and the Holy Spirit descends like a dove upon Him. Then we hear God pronounce, **"This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."** (Matthew 3: 17b ESV)

As you look at the painting you can see that Jesus is standing in the water of the Jordan River (WESTERN or Eastern shore?) with John the Baptist to His right about to anoint Him. On the left, balancing out the picture, you have two angels who appear to be gazing in two different directions-why? Well, that was the question I posed to my students. *I am not sure if there is a right answer!* The students also noticed the outstretched hands of God the Father at the top of the picture along with the 'dove-like' shape above Jesus' head. Right there, you have a wonderful illustration of the Trinity!

Sometimes if we slow down long enough to look at things and not at 'sound bites' we will often see solid theology right before our eyes. Here we have a beautiful illustration of the Trinity. Art, I believe has a way of speaking directly and intimately with our souls.
